Date: March 22, 2023

Topic: **Jesus Is Coming Soon!**

**During this month of revival, we will review various scriptures or highlights from Sunday's sermon.*

Introduction: In tonight's reading, you will notice a loving Savior—Jesus Christ, answering a question of concern asked by His followers. They wanted to know what signs they should look for to indicate His return and that the end of the world was near. Jesus answered them in detail of things that they could expect before His return and compared it to the days of Noah. Jesus did not intend to incite fear but to alert as well as warn His followers to be aware of the times. Therefore, Sunday's sermon was given to remind us, the believers as well as unbelievers, that what Jesus spoke of then, is now upon us. For the scripture says that *we know not the hour that our Lord will return (Matthew 24:42)*. As a result, we must pay attention to the signs and always be ready for His return.

Read: **Matthew 24:3-40**

Think & Discuss: **After reading Matthew 24:3-40, what are some of your thoughts? Discuss.**

How did Jesus describe the days of Noah? What were people doing? How does this compare to the coming of Christ? Discuss.

What are some ways that you can spread the message of Christ's coming to unbelievers?

Takeaway: The message of Christ's return is not one that should be seen as scary. Instead, it is message to alert all believers that each day we must pay attention to the signs and prepare ourselves for a coming King. In addition, because we know what to look for according to the scriptures, we should warn unbelievers that the time is now to accept Jesus Christ as their savior because He is coming back soon.
